We warmly welcome Archbishop Eugene Nugent who will be back in Tuamgraney for the month of July. He will celebrate Mass in Tuamgraney Church at 10am on a day to day basis, beginning on Monday July 1st.

Please note: There will be no Saturday evening masses in Ogonnelloe during the months of July and August. Sunday Masses will continue throughout July at 11am in St. Molua's and will change to St. Mary's from Sunday 4th August.

Where there is injury, pardon;

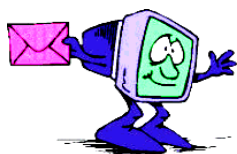
where there is doubt, faith;
