From December 1st, First Sunday of Advent, the Mass schedule in the Parish will change. Changes will turn over on a monthly basis. In December Mass will be on Saturdays in Tuamgraney at 6.30pm. In January Mass will be on Sundays in Bodyke at 9.30am. When Mass is in Tuamgraney on Saturdays, there will be no Mass in Bodyke on Sundays. In January Saturday Mass will be in Scariff at 6.30pm.

For November masses remain as they are at present.

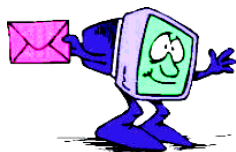
