It was with great sadness that we heard of the death of Bishop Emeritus Willie Walsh last Wednesday, February 19th, at the age of ninety.

Although a Tipperary man, he had a great allegiance to Clare having spent many years teaching in St Flannan's College. He also spent time as a selector for Clare hurling and we remember with fondness his association with the All Ireland winning Clare teams of the 1990s. Bishop Willie served as Bishop of Killaloe from 1994 to 2010 and continued to reside in Ennis following his retirement. We extend our sympathy to his family, colleagues, and many friends. May he rest in peace.


