Tulla History Group will be having its next History talk on Monday 10th March at 8pm in Tulla Courthouse. The guest speaker on the night will be Dr. Catherine Porter: Beyond the Map - County Clare in the first Ordnance Survey of Ireland. This lecture will focus on the project 0S200: Digitally Re-Mapping Ireland's Ordnance Survey Heritage, whereby a research team based at the University of Limerick and Queen's University Belfast sought to bring together, for the first time, the maps, memoirs, name books, and letters from the first Ordnance Survey into a freely accessible digital resource. Using examples from County Clare, this lecture will explore the archive and demonstrate how the resource can be used by the public and researchers. Dr. Catherine Porter is an Associate Professor and Head of Geography in the School of History and Geography at the University of Limerick. Her research focuses on innovative approaches to analysing early maps and texts, particularly the history of mapping. Please come along for what promises to be a very informative talk.
